How do I join?

To become a member of AGS a student must:

- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and must be currently enrolled with at least six units at West Los Angeles College.
- Have completed twelve semester units with a GPA of 3.0 or higher at a recognized institution of higher education; or have graduated with a minimum GPA of 3.5 at the high school level.
